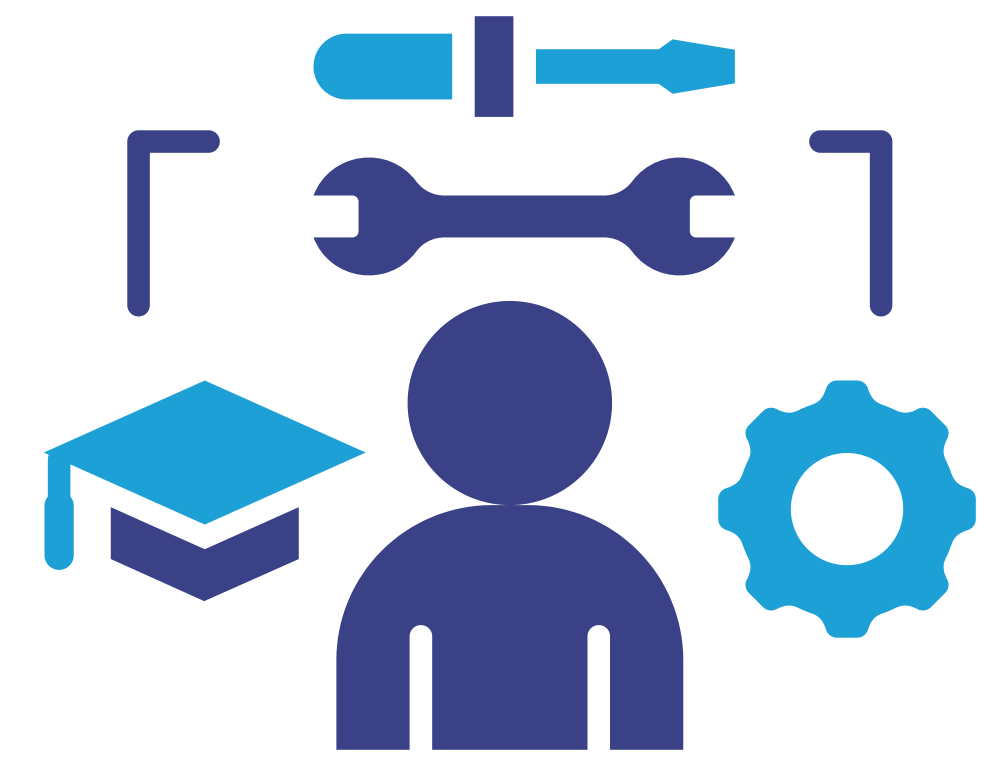

- Reskilling: Training employees to take on new roles or responsibilities.

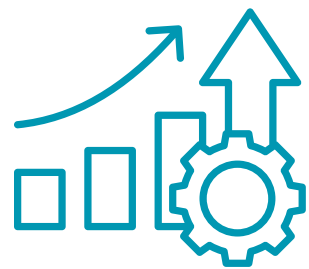
