

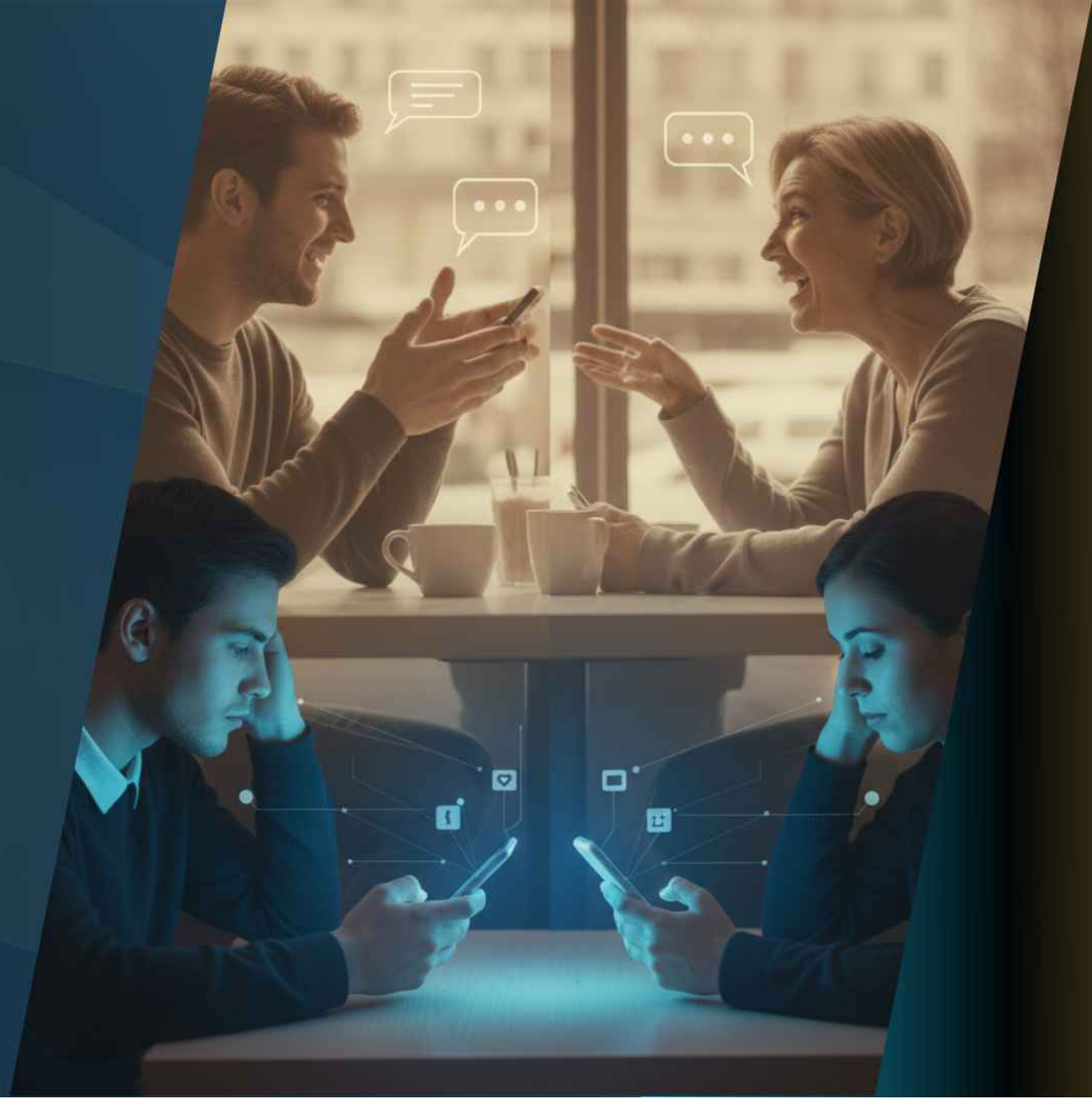

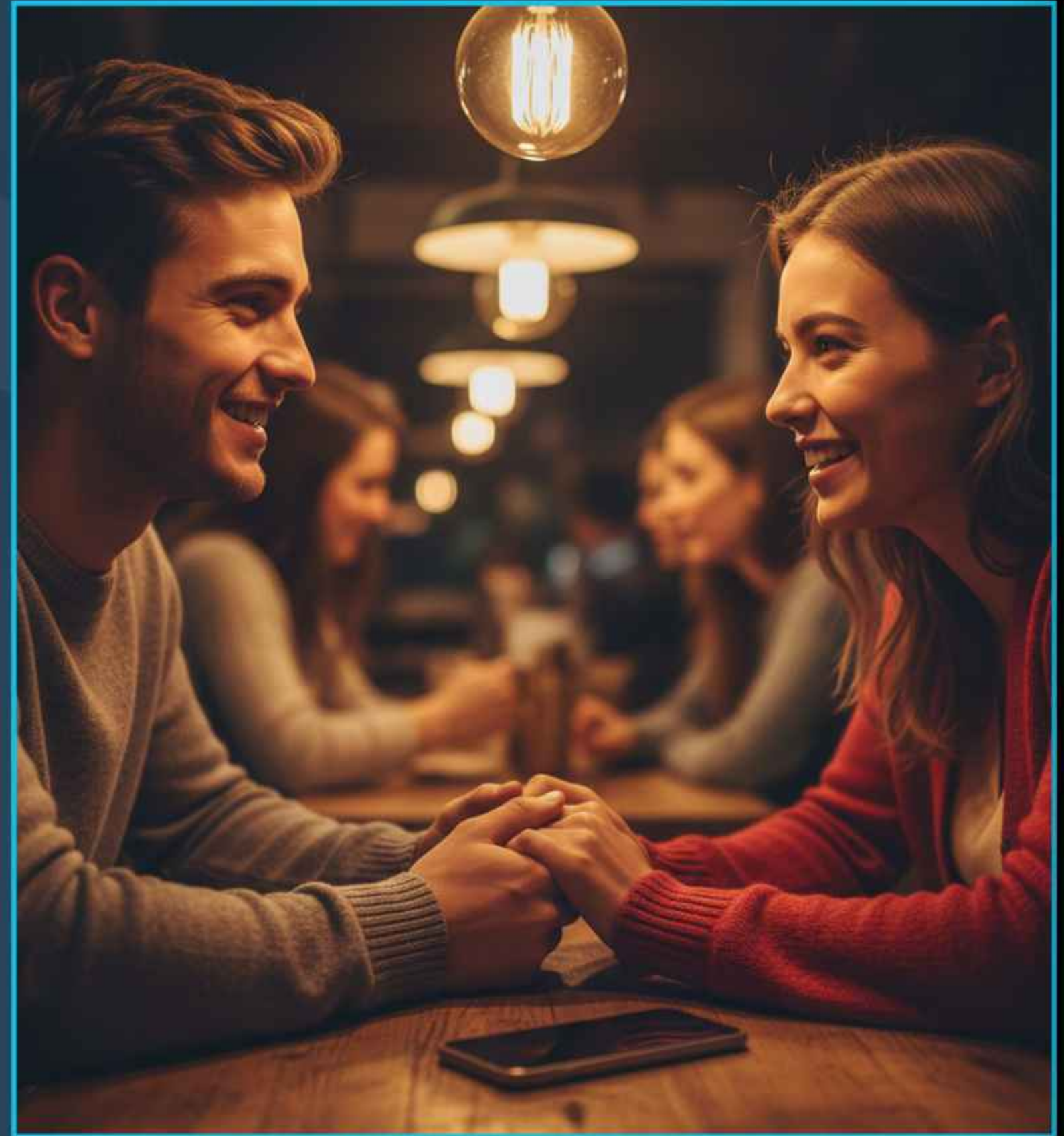


BALANCING ONLINE AND OFFLINE INTERACTION
