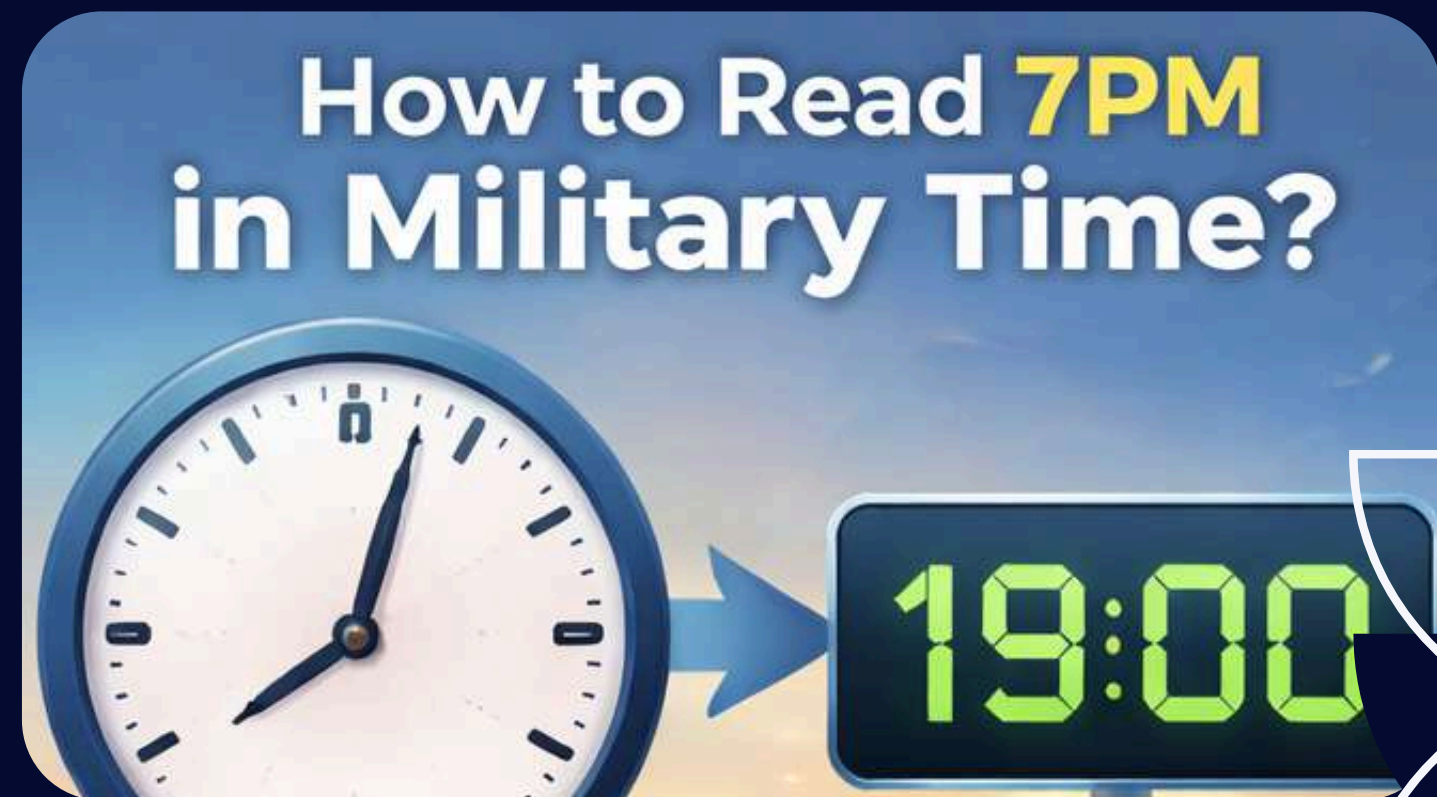


# Is 7PM Military Time Confusing Or Surprisingly Simple To Understand?
